WORDS FROM PASTOR DAN

Our year came to an end in a world we never could have imagined. This year brought uncertainty, change and fear that lingers on. It also generated a new awareness of our need for community, compassion and hope. I've gained so much strength by paying attention to how Jesus is still at work in the world.

Not the least of which was how He compelled you to invest your valuable time and finances in the Kingdom of God through North Central Church. By doing so, you helped reach hundreds of people right here in our local church on Sundays, our neighborhood communities and all around the globe. Your time was invested in developing, strengthening and joining the teams we needed to continue to meet and broadcast on Sundays. Your giving helped support struggling families, feed frontline workers and fueled our technology efforts; allowing us to expand the way we shared the good news message of gospel transformation through our online weekend services.



We are living through a challenging phase of history where all churches are being refined and redefined. This past year stands out to me as a year full of T's – **turmoil**, **teamwork and togetherness**.

The **turmoil** was both private and public. The sickness, suffering, isolation, uncertainty, political upheaval and division among the evangelical church has presented some unique challenges for churches like ours. My heart remains heavy with all of the small and big ways our church family is suffering through a variety of losses. Saying goodbye to families who have moved, letting go of normal and accepting change sure does feel like grief sometimes. A source of strength and inspiration for me has come through the teamwork of our church leadership and staff. To lead more effectively in the face of this unusual turmoil, our team felt challenged to pivot into using some new meeting formats and tools like Staff Chapel, a new church App, live stream, video meetings and video messaging. There's been measurable fruit from these changes and we are praying and planning for effective strategies to accomplish the mission of reproducing disciples in a multiplying church.

The more we were forced apart this past year, the more we cherished being together. I have never been so thankful for the togetherness God provides through small groups, one-on-one conversation (even by video!) and an in-person Sunday worship service. In a season of aloneness and quarantine, any and all sense of togetherness has been a gift from God.

I'm more confident than ever that God has already given us the wisdom and peace we need to do anything together. This includes making it through any of the challenges ahead. I am so deeply grateful for your fruitful devotion to care for and serve your NCC family in every way you did.

From the bottom of my heart and from all the way down in my bones, thank you for your sacrificial giving and for joining us on our mission to see everyone transformed and mobilized by the good news of Jesus. There's so much more work to be done -- new challenges, new opportunities, new people.

WORDS FROM PASTOR JONATHAN

The vision of North Central Church is to see gospel transformation in every heart, home, and neighborhood. The best way we know how to accomplish that vision is to create environments that equip all people to treasure Jesus, live in community, and embody a missionary lifestyle

We believe that happens most effectively when we recognize that the church is not a building, but a people. A life of worship means carrying our missionary identity everywhere we go. It means a life shared with neighbors, co-workers, and friends. It means a life lived in gospel-freedom outside the brick and mortar of the North Central building. Never has that been more true than in this past year.

With the upheaval that 2020 brought, sharing our lives together looked a whole lot different than it ever has. None of us could have imagined the full impact of a pandemic, nor will we fully realize it for years down the road. I'm heart-broken for families that have lost loved ones to Covid-19, and can't imagine the hurt, confusion, and grief. Megan and I continue to be moved to pray for those that continue to find their lives tossed into uncertainty.

Add to that an evangelical church that continues to wrestle with who she is, who she'll be, and who she belongs to - all within the backdrop of massive social and political transition and change. I can't remember a year with events that elicited the kind of emotional and visceral response that 2020 did, much of it with cause.

And yet...somehow...Jesus builds His church, and He invites us into His work.

Clearly this past year brought challenges, but it also brought opportunities. I'm so proud of the way our team responded as we navigated uncharted waters. Truth is, it could have gone very differently. Here's what I mean.

1. A mandatory shut-down could have meant that North Central went dark for 3 months. Instead it meant we got to work delivering a reliable live-stream of our Sunday service and weekly video content from church-leaders, which continues today and into the foreseeable future.



2. Tight re-opening restrictions could have meant chaos and confusion. Instead we put policies in place that allowed anyone who wanted to return to do so safely and with clear guidelines.

3. Not being able to meet mid-week throughout the summer could have meant disconnection and stalled-out momentum. Instead we developed Church@Home and met via Zoom which paved the way for our Continuing The Conversation Small Groups that launched this past January.

4. The challenges of child-care during a pandemic could have meant our Kid Central building was shuttered. Instead our incredible KC team rallied and provided a solution (KCCNY Remote Learning Center) to a child-care problem parents in our community would have never imagined.

None of this happens without the expertise of support staff, ministry leaders, and tech & media volunteers that are committed to using their time and talent to see gospel-transformation occurring in hearts, homes, and neighborhoods. I'm so humbled to be able to contribute towards that vision. A vision I believe in today more than ever, and one I won't stop working towards in whatever ways God enables me.






SUNDAY MORNINGS


Teams



This is a structured program with an emphasis on school first and fun activities after all school work is done.
